WHAT YOU'LL DO

The Leadership Development Coordinator (LD coordinator) will be a key member of Vizazi Uganda, reporting to the National Ministry Director. The LD Coordinator will be able to identify, train, coordinate, and evaluate teams in leadership development and publishing across the country. They will also oversee any volunteers in LD and the publishing section.

Specifically, the LD Coordinator will...

- Teach, refine, and develop Vizazi Uganda Model Children's Worker training/development programs.
- Lead in implementing leadership development strategies that reflect Vizazi Uganda's mission, values, and leadership development strategies.
- Lead the Leadership Development team to develop, refine and implement a leadership development, multiplication strategy that includes programs for Model Children Workers, leaders-of-leaders, and regional and District leaders (Volunteers).
- Develop an effective National Leadership Development and publishing team within the country
- Work with the Leadership Development and publishing team to identify the Leadership Development needs of the National ministry, then develop and implement needed leadership development programs.
- Identify and lead the Publishing team to develop curriculum and teaching materials as needed
- Work with the National Director and Leadership Development team to realize a growing number of Model Children Workers in the Country.
- Monitor and evaluate the success of the Leadership Development programs/projects, through goal setting, designing surveys, and analyzing data
- Publicize and sell all materials developed by the publishing team
- Coordinate with churches to organize special activities with children e.g Bible camps, children evangelism, seminars, etc.
- Develop and maintain a functional database for all Leadership Development in the country
- Work with the National Director to develop a ministry whose operations are funded by the local Christian community.
